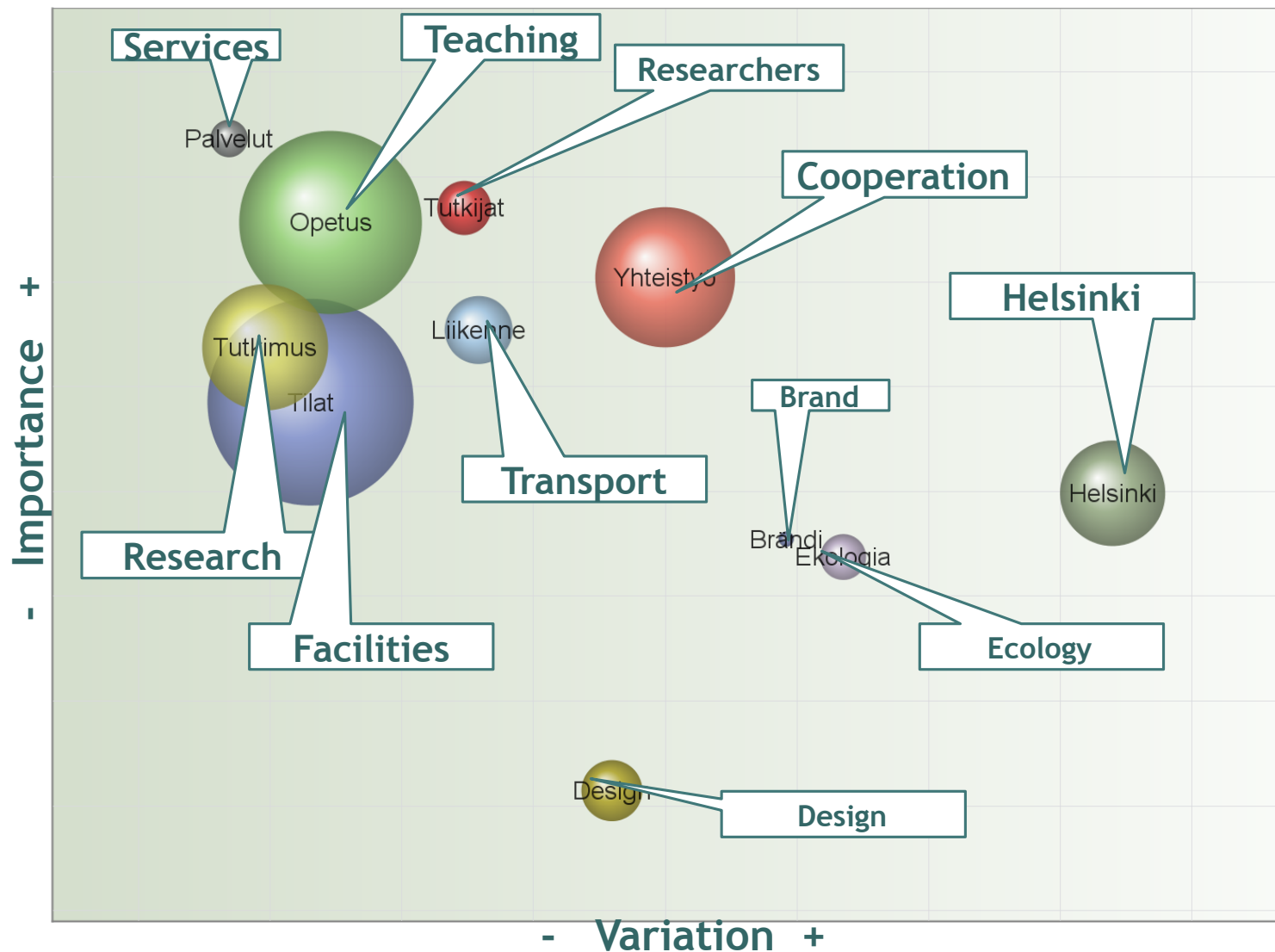

Important elements of the learning environment



The larger the bubble, the more mentions there are about the matter.

The self-evidently major themes in the discussion were facilities, teaching and research, the importance of which has smaller variation. Co-operation also emerges as important, although it exhibits somewhat greater variation.

What is important on a campus

- **People** come first, not facilities - a campus is above all a community
- A campus should be pleasant and **meaningful** - and a place for social innovations
- **Open access** and free use of facilities - easy to come to, to leave and to live in
- A campus is an enabler of **cooperation** at all levels
- Aalto University must be **seen and heard** - it is in the midst of society
- Enables **teaching** in small groups, project work and convertible facilities
- Attracts the world's best **professors** and enables better **student-teacher relationships**
- **Ecologically** the best in the world
- **Peace** to work and time to think
- **User-friendliness** in planning process
